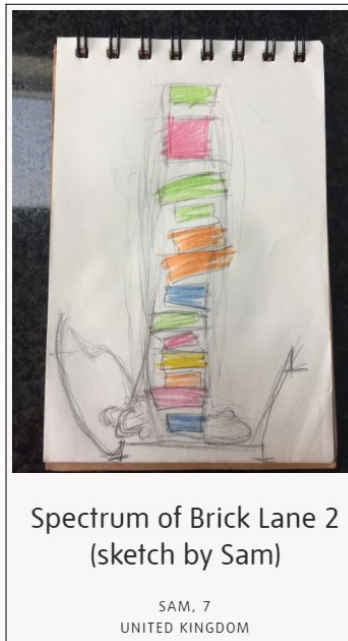
ART COMPETITION
