## THIS WEEK'S BOOK REVIEW

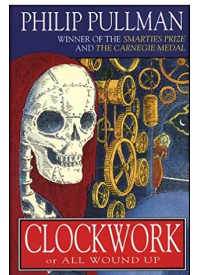
**Clockwork** by Philip Pullman

## THE MANDEVILLE SCHOOL UNIFORM

The Mandeville school uniform is an essential and integral part of Mandeville school life. It is part of our identity and embodies the collective spirit of the children. On a practical level, our uniform helps safeguard our children whilst learning outside of the school, enabling them to be easily monitored and identified. The uniform expectations are as follows:

### Standard Uniform

#### Girls

- Grey skirt/Pinafore Dress/Trousers
- White Polo-Shirt/White Blouse
- Royal Blue Sweatshirt with school logo (available in School Office, also pictured below)
- Black Low-heeled Shoes
- White Socks (Long)
- Girls may wear a head scarf in Royal Blue/Black/Navy/White (White to be worn with Summer Uniform). This is removed for P.E.

#### Boys

- Grey Trousers (Please note: NOT grey jogging bottoms)
- White Polo-Shirt/White Shirt
- Royal Blue Sweatshirt with school logo (available in School Office, also pictured below)



## SCHOOL UNIFORM CONTINUED.....

### Summer Uniform

#### Girls

- Royal Blue Gingham Dress
- Grey Shorts (Optional)
- White Ankle Socks
- Plain Legionnaire-style Hats are recommended

#### Boys

- Grey Shorts (Optional)
- Plain Legionnaire-style Hats are recommended

**P.E. Uniform** All children must change for P.E.

#### Girls

- Navy Shorts
- White T-Shirt
- Plimsolls
- Navy/Black Swimming Costume (one piece suits; no bikinis)

#### Boys

- Navy Shorts
- White T-Shirt
- Plimsolls
- Navy/Black Swimming Costume (tight trunks or shorts; no beach shorts)

### Important Note

All long hair must be tied back. Jewellery must not be worn. For those with pierced ears, a small discreet stud only may be worn. These must, however, be removed or covered with a plaster by the child for P.E. lessons. Nail Varnish may also not be worn in school.
