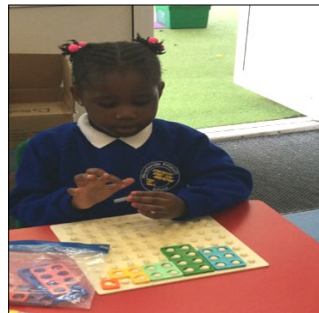

RECEPTION CLASS NEWS

They have spent time getting to know their new teachers and friends and have been exploring their new classroom and outdoor area. The children have also begun to learn their initial set sounds— this week they have learnt the sounds M, S, A, D, T.

**SCHOOL STREETS**

School Streets is a Hackney Council scheme changing roads outside schools, so that only pedestrians and cyclists can use them at school start and finish times.

The aim of the scheme is to tackle congestion and improve air quality at the school gates, making it easier and safer to walk and cycle to school. Hackney Council have recently announced that they are extending the School Streets scheme to include the roads around many more schools and Mandeville School is one of these new areas. This means that Oswald Street, from the junction with Millfields Road to the junction with Pedro Street, will be made a Pedestrian and Cycle Zone for one hour in the morning and afternoon, from **8:30-9:30am** and **3:00-4:00pm**. The scheme will not operate on weekends or during school holidays. Only residents who have been granted an exemption will be allowed to enter the zone during these times by car. Drivers entering the zone without an exemption will be fined (cameras will be in place at the end of September when fixed penalty notices will start).

Your vehicle(s) will automatically be exempt from this School Streets zone if you are a resident or business within this School Streets zone and have a Hackney resident's parking permit registered to your vehicle(s). You may also be granted a special exemption if you, or your child attending the school, are a Blue Badge holder who needs vehicle access to a property in a School Streets zone, including the school.
