YR 6 VISIT HACKNEY MUSEUM

Last week, Year 6 went on an exciting trip to Hackney Museum as part of their history unit looking at protests across history. The focus of this visit was protests that have taken place in Hackney over the last one hundred years, of which there have been many. Issues covered ranged from journalism into the working conditions faced by women in early 20th Century London, to campaigns by school children aimed at tackling fascism. The

children were able to look at sources from the Hackney Archives, using these to make inferences about the different protests. It was truly inspiring to learn about how local people have campaigned on the issues that matter to them most, from issues of local politics to those with international significance.
