

Primary sports and PE funding 2014-2015

The government is providing additional funding of £150 million per annum for academic years 2014-2015 to improve the provision of physical education (PE) and sport in primary schools. This funding can be only spent on PE and sports in primary schools. Schools must use this money to improve their PE provision and ensuring each child has the opportunity to live an active and healthy lifestyle.

Mandeville has been allocated **£9,485**. The table below shows a breakdown of how we have spent this funding at our school.
